#### 2. Introduction

Starting from 2023 season there are important changes on how results XML has to be prepared for individual Ski Cross competitions – the XML file will have to provide more data about the competition.

In the very near future Ski Cross will adapt a new FIS points calculation which will rely not only on the competitors final rank but also on the time achieved in the qualification phase. While there are still cases where Ski Cross competitions are held without timed qualification, it is being investigated how points will be calculated for those competitions.

To allow running a "shadow" season and have the proposed new FIS points calculated in the background, starting with 2023 season there will be additional data that has to be added to the XML files:

- 1. Data about the format of the qualification and final phases
- 2. When timed qualification is held (seeding or qualification) also the qualification times have to be sent via XML



#### 3. Changes to sending XML results

There are two major changes to how XML results will need to be sent starting from 2023 season – information about the competition is required and also qualification phase times have to be sent when applicable. These changes apply only to events that are not of category "QUA". In case there is a separate qualifying codex, the format and time information is mandatory only when sending the results for final codex.

#### 3.1. Sending the competition format information

Competition format information has to be sent within he <FS\_raceinfo> element by specifying format information via the <Qualificationformat> and <Finalformat> element attributes.

To specify the qualification format:

The <Qualificationformat> element accepts two attributes:

#### 3.2. Sending the qualification times

Whenever <Qualificationformat> element has attribute Format set to seeding or qualification, it is mandatory to send result achieved in the qualification phase by sending <Totaltime> within the <FS\_result> element:
