Scope

Candidates and holders of official positions in FIS bodies who are subject to eligibility checks are obliged to collaborate in providing information regarding their eligibility. In particular, they shall comply with requests for any documents, information or any other material of any nature held by them, upon reasonable notice. In addition, they shall comply with the procurement and provision of documents, information or any other material of any nature not held by them but which they are entitled to obtain. This Questionnaire was approved by the FIS Council on 13 February 2019.

7. I confirm that I must notify the body conducting the eligibility check of any relevant facts and circumstances arising after the eligibility check has been completed, and that failure to do so may be subject to sanctions by FIS.
8. I confirm that I am obliged to collaborate to establish the relevant facts with regard to the eligibility check. In particular, I will comply with requests for any documents, information or any other material of any nature held by me. In addition, I will comply with the procurement and provision of documents, information or any other material of any nature not held by me, but which I am entitled to obtain. I am fully aware and confirm that non-compliance with such requests may lead to sanctions imposed by FIS.

I confirm that the body conducting the eligibility check may also request information on possible sanctions (questions 1 and 2 above) directly from the relevant confederation or FIS member association as well as from other institutions such as the Court of Arbitration for Sport or the International Olympic Committee. In this regard, I hereby release the relevant institutions from any obligation of confidentiality relating to the information concerned.
10. I am fully aware and confirm that FIS may collect further information on me as a result of the eligibility check.
