

PREVIEW MEN'S SUPER TEAM LARGE HILL WISLA – Saturday 13 Jan 2024

- This is the third Super team event, after last season's large hill event in Lake Placid and normal hill event in Râsnov, both in February 2023.
- **Poland's** Dawid Kubacki and Piotr Zyla won the event in Lake Placid last season, and Germany's Andreas Wellinger and Karl Geiger won in Râsnov.
- Kubacki won the most recent World Cup events in Wisla, both individual large hill events on 5 and 6 November 2021.
- **Austria** is the only country to have claimed a podium finish in both Super Team event last season: **Stefan Kraft** and Daniel Totschnig in the large hill event in Lake Placid and Clemens Aigner and Philipp Aschenwald in the normal hill event in Râsnov.
- Austria won the last three World Cup team events in Wisla (2019, 2020, 2021). Stefan Kraft and Daniel Huber were part of all three winning teams.
- Kraft holds the record with four wins and 10 podium finishes in Wisla in all World Cup events.
- Four Hills winner **Ryoyu Kobayashi's** best result in a World Cup event in Wisla was a third place in the individual large hill event on 18 November 2018.
- Kobayashi and Naoki Nakamura claimed **Japan's** only podium finish in a Super Team event when they finished third in Lake Placid last season.
