

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA 2023/2024 FOR THE FIS PARA ALPINE SKIING

WORLD CUP EUROPA CUP NORTH AMERICAN CUP

1 General Principles

- 1.1 To compete in the World Cup, Europa Cup and North American Cup competitions all Athletes must:
 - have a valid 2023/2024 FIS licence issued in accordance with the art.
 203 of the ICR; and
 - be internationally classified with a Sport Class Status Confirmed (C) or Review (R) with a Fixed Review Date 2024 or later (i.e., Review 2024 or later).

2 World Cup

- 2.1 For Technical Events:
 - All Athletes must have 160 FIS Points or less to be qualified.
 - For SL events, Athletes can qualify through <u>SL FIS Points only</u>.
 - For GS events, Athletes can qualify through GS FIS Points only.
- 2.2 For Speed Events:
 - All Athletes must have 140 FIS Points or less to be qualified.
 - For DH, SG and AC events, Athletes can qualify through <u>SG or DH FIS</u> <u>Points</u>.

3 Europa Cup and North American Cup

- 3.1 For Technical Events:
 - All Athletes must have 300 FIS Points or less to be qualified.
 - For SL and GS events, Athletes can qualify through SL or GS FIS Points.
- 3.2.1 For Speed Events:
 - All Athletes must have <u>280 FIS Points or less</u> to be qualified.
 - For DH, SG and AC events, Athletes can qualify through <u>SG or DH FIS</u> Points.
