

## PREVIEW MEN'S SUPER TEAM LARGE HILL LAKE PLACID – Saturday 10 Feb 2024

- This is the fourth World Cup Super team event. All previous editions were won by different countries: Poland, Germany and Slovenia.
- **Poland's** Dawid Kubacki and Piotr Zyla won the event in Lake Placid last season, ahead of Austria (2nd) and Japan (3rd).
- Poland can become the first country to win multiple Super team events at a single venue.
- **Slovenia's** Anže Lanišek and Lovro Kos won the most recent men's World Cup Super team event, in Wisla on 13 January.
- **Austria** is the only country to have claimed a podium finish in all three Super Team events: second in Lake Placid, third in Râsnov and second in Wisla.
- **Stefan Kraft** (35) is level with Gregor Schlierenzauer (35) for most World Cup podiums in men's team events.
- Ryoyu Kobayashi and Naoki Nakamura claimed **Japan's** only podium finish in a Super Team event when they finished third in Lake Placid last season.
- Japan won the only regular men's World Cup team event in United States, in Salt Lake City on 19 January 2001.
- No man has recorded as many podiums in World Cup Super team events as Germany's **Andreas Wellinger** (2). He finished first in Râsnov (with Karl Geiger) and third in Wisla (with Stephan Leyhe).
