Eligibility Criteria

Each NSA may register:

- 1 female athlete (plus guide, for VI athletes);
- 1 male athlete (plus guide, for VI athletes); and
- 1 coach
- Athletes must have an active FIS Code
- All participants must sign the FIS Development Camp declaration

Equipment

Participants must bring all necessary ski equipment to participate in the camp. FIS does not provide for any kind of ski equipment.

Insurance

All participants must have adequate medical and accident insurance. Please bring a copy of your insurance policy with you to the camp in case of an emergency.

Registration will be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis for eligible athletes. All NSAs who register will be notified of their participation by the latest one week after the Deadline.

Athletes are obliged to attend the full period of the Training Camp. If they do not, they will not be allowed to participate in future Training Camps organised by FIS (except in case of injury).

The camp coordinator and coaches reserve the right to send any athlete who needs to meet the necessary level for training home early.
