FIS Development Training Camp – Ski Jumping/Nordic Combined 2026

Dear Ski friends,

We are pleased to invite athletes and coaches from your National Ski Association (NSA) to participate in the FIS Development Program Ski Jumping/Nordic Combined Training Camp in Planica and Villach (SLO). Information about the camp is as follows:

Dates

12 October 2026 (arrival) to 17 October 2026 (departure)

Ski Jumping Hills in Planica

The hill sizes in Planica are: HS45, HS61, HS80, HS104 and HS139; therefore, athletes must be able to jump on these hills.

Accommodation

Hotel Kompas, Borovška cesta 100, Kranjska Gora

Eligibility Criteria

- Each NSA may register:
 - 2 athletes (**1female/1male**) + 1 Coach for Ski Jumping; and
 - 2 athletes (**1female/1male**) + 1 Coach for Nordic Combined
- Athletes must:
 - be aged 13-19 years
 - have an active FIS Code
 - be capable of training on the specified hills listed above for safety reasons

All participants must sign the FIS Development Camp declaration and be entered by the NSA via the registration link provided.

Insurance

All participants must be covered with adequate medical and accident insurance and should carry their personal insurance card with them in case of an accident.

Equipment

Participants must bring all necessary equipment for the camp, including, but not limited to:

- **All disciplines**
 - Running shoes & indoor shoes
 - Personal drinking bottle
- **Discipline-specific - Nordic Combined (Cross country)**
 - Skating roller skis, boots, and poles

- Protection (gloves, helmets, glasses)
- **Discipline-specific - Ski Jumping / Nordic Combined (SJ)**
 - Ski Jumping equipment (skis, boots, suit, helmet, ski glasses, gloves)

Note: NSAs may cancel participation latest 48 Hours after receiving the confirmation of participation letter. After the deadline for cancellation, FIS will issue an invoice for the full camp fees to the NSA Account. Registration

The FIS Development Program will support a maximum of 34 participants. Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis for eligible athletes and coaches. NSAs with 1 and 2 voting rights will be given priority for the FIS-supported places.

All registered participants are obliged to attend the full period of the Training Camp. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from future camps organised by FIS (except in cases of injury).
