World Cup points

Athletes will be able to score up to 1500 points in the World Cup, taking

all Individual competitions into consideration.

Trophies The Best Jumper and Best Skier Trophy leader will wear a bib with a blue

and red mark instead of a start number and will also receive prize money at the end of the season. If an athlete owns two bibs at the same time, the lower ranked bib will be worn by the second placed athlete in the respective

ranking. A mini crystal globe will be given to the best athlete of the Individual Compact format and the Individual Mass Start, at the end of the season.

Overall Best Jumper / Skier Trophy: 1.785 EUR
