

Statistics - WOMEN'S GUNDERSEN NORMAL HILL/5KM WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS TRONDHEIM

Gyda Westvold Hansen

- Gyda Westvold Hansen became the first women's world champion as she won the inaugural edition in Oberstdorf in 2021.
- \circ She defended her title in Planica 2023 winning the gold medal at this event at successive World Championships.
- \circ With three victories (2 Individual, 1 Mixed Team), Westvold Hansen won a gold medal at every World Championship competition of the women so far.
- $\circ\,$ This season, Westvold Hansen reached the World Cup podium seven times, but has not claimed a victory yet.

Ida Marie Hagen

- Ida Marie Hagen placed 4th in the women's Individual Gundersen at the World Championships 2023, 14 seconds behind rank three.
- \circ She has won 3 out of 4 Individual Gundersen events this season.
- Hagen won the last World Cup competition in Trondheim in March 2024, also claiming the Overall World Cup title 2023-24.

Other contenders

- Nathalie Armbruster won the silver medal at the women's Individual Gundersen in Planica 2023. She reached the World Cup podium eight times in 12 competitions this season, including 3 times in a Gundersen, leading the Overall World Cup ranking.
- Haruka Kasai placed third in Planica and finished fourth at this event at the 2021 World Championships. She reached the podium seven times this season, including three third places at Gundersen events.
- Yuna Kasai placed 5th in this event in 2023. Her best Gundersen results this season were 4th places in Otepää and Schonach.
- Marte Leinan Lund finished third in this event at the 2021 world championships. Her best result in this event this season was a 5th place in Schonach.
- Mari Leinan Lund who finished second behind Gyda Westvold Hansen in this event at the 2021 world championships will not be on start in Trondheim due to a knee injury.
- \circ Lisa Hirner's placed 10th in this event in Planica. Her best Gundersen result this season was a 3rd place in Lillehammer.
