Eligibility

- Each NSA may register:
 - 1 female athlete, 1 male athlete; and
 - 1 coach
- Athletes must:
 - be born between 1st January 2007 - 31st December 2011 (Junior World Ski Championships age group).
 - have an active FIS Code
- Coaches must:
 - hold a national and/or international coaches' certificate.
 - have coaching experience, at least on the national level for 2 years

All participants must sign the FIS Development Camp declaration and be entered by the NSA via the registration link provided.

Equipment

Participants must bring all necessary equipment for the camp, including:

- Running shoes (both road and trail) and indoor shoes
- Drinking bottle

- Watch, Pulsometer
- Roller Ski equipment Classic*
 - Subject to availability, FIS DP will provide Classic Roller skis for 30 people (to be confirmed in the confirmation letter). Participants must provide boots and ski-poles.
- Protection (gloves, helmets, glasses)
- Sun protection

Insurance

All athletes and coaches must have adequate medical and accident insurance. Please bring a copy of your insurance policy with you to the camp in case of an emergency.

Registration

The camp is limited to 24 participants. Registration will be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis for eligible athletes and coaches.

All NSAs who register will be notified of their participation by the latest one week after the Deadline.

All registered participants are obliged to attend the full period of the Training Camp. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from future camps organised by FIS (except in cases of injury).
