

Audi FIS Alpine Ski World Cup 2025/26 – Men's Slalom

Hafjell stat sheet

Previous SL race (Kranjska Gora) stats

- **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** won the most recent Slalom race in Kranjska Gora on March 8th. The runner-up was **Henrik Kristoffersen (NOR/Van Deer)**, with **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)** finishing in 3rd place.
- **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** has the lead in the Slalom World Cup standings before the season finale with 552 points, 41 points ahead of **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)**. **Clement Noel (FRA/Dynastar)** is in third with 475 points.
- **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** won his third race of the season, which one more than **Paco Rassat (FRA/Head)**. No other athlete managed more than one win this season so far.
- **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** has won more than one race in a single season only once before in 2021/22. McGrath finished third in the Crystal Globe race that year, which is the only time he has finished on the Slalom season-long podium to date.
- 2nd place in Kranjska Gora Slalom allowed **Henrik Kristoffersen (NOR/Van Deer)** to take the lead in the list of athletes with the most top-3 finishes there. No other athlete has claimed seven podium finishes in Kranjska Gora to date.
- A podium finish in Kranjska Gora allowed **Henrik Kristoffersen (NOR/Van Deer)** to take the undisputed 3rd place on the all-time list with 102 career World Cup men's podiums. **Ingemar Stenmark (SWE)** leads the way with 155 podiums.
- **Atle Lie McGrath (Head)** has the most Slalom World Cup podiums in the current season - six. **Henrik Kristoffersen (Van Deer)** has five and **Clement Noel (FRA/Dynastar)** four. No other athlete claimed more than three podium finishes.
- **Atle Lie McGrath (Head)** and **Henrik Kristoffersen (Van Deer)** helped Norway to the second Slalom World Cup 1-2 of the season and the second one in a row. **Kristoffersen** won ahead of **McGrath** in Schladming. Norway are the only nation with a 1-2 during the two most recent seasons: **Henrik Kristoffersen / Timon Haugan (Van Deer)** in Kranjska Gora 2024/25, **Henrik Kristoffersen / Atle Lie McGrath** in Val d'Isere 2024/25 and a podium sweep in Wengen 2024/25 with **Atle Lie McGrath** in 1st, **Timon Haugan** in 2nd and **Henrik Kristoffersen** in 3rd.
- **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)** has finished inside the top-10 of every Slalom (1st, 2nd, 3rd, four times 4th, 5th, 10th and a DNF) and every Giant Slalom (1st, three times 2nd, 5th, 7th, 10th and a DNF) race he has managed to finish during the 2025/26 season.

- Four athletes are still in the contest for the Slalom Crystal globe with one race to go: **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)**, **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic; 41 points behind)**, **Clement Noel (FRA/Dynastar; 77)** and **Henrik Kristoffersen (NOR/Van Deer; 99)**.
- **Henrik Kristoffersen (NOR/Van Deer)** has won the Slalom Globe four times - in 2015/16, 2019/20, 2021/22 and 2024/25; **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)** - once in 2022/23, representing Norway. There are two other active athletes who are out of the Globe race this season, but topped the Slalom season standings in the past: **Marco Schwarz (AUT/Atomic; 2020/21)** and **Manuel Feller (AUT/Atomic; 2023/24)**.
- A place on the podium in Hafjell will guarantee **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** the Slalom Crystal Globe. If **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** finishes off the podium, he can still secure the Slalom Globe provided his opponents fail to score 41 points more than him.
- **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)** needs to score 42 points more than **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** to clinch the Globe, provided his other opponents score no more than 35 points more than him.
- **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)** is currently second in both technical disciplines' World Cup standings. Pinheiro Braathen has finished inside the top-10 of every Slalom (1st, 2nd, 3rd, four times 4th, 5th, 10th and a DNF) and every Giant Slalom (1st, three times 2nd, 5th, 7th, 10th and a DNF) race he has managed to finish during the 2025/26 season.
- **Loic Meillard (SUI/ Rossignol)** won the 2024/25 Hafjell Slalom race, which was the last Slalom win for team Switzerland to date. The runner-up was **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)**, with **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)** finishing in 3rd place.
- Norwegian athletes have never won a Slalom World Cup race on home slopes in 16 attempts since the 1968/69 season.
- Norway has won 50% of the races this season. **Atle Lie McGrath's (Head)** won three, **Timon Haugan (Van Deer)** and **Henrik Kristoffersen (Van Deer)** have one win both. Five other races were claimed by France (three), Austria and Brazil (one each).
- If **Clement Noel (FRA/Dynastar)** wins in Hafjell he will join **Marc Girardelli (LUX)** in the 5th place on the all-time for the most men's World Cup Slalom wins with 16. **Ingemar Stenmark (SWE)** leads the field with 40 Slalom victories.
- **Lucas Pinheiro Braathen (BRA/Atomic)** and **Clement Noel (FRA/Dynastar)** are looking to extend their streak of seven consecutive Slalom World Cup top-10 finishes. This is the longest career streak for both athletes. **Henrik Kristoffersen (NOR/Van Deer)** holds

the longest streak of 15 consecutive Slalom World Cup top-10 finishes, achieved during the 2014/15-2015/16 seasons.

- **Atle Lie McGrath (Head)** needs one more podium finish to claim the 3rd place on his own for the most Slalom World Cup podiums among Norwegian athletes. Currently he is on par with **Finn Christian Jagge (NOR)** at 17 both. **Henrik Kristoffersen (Van Deer)** leads this list with 61 top-3 results.
- A win by **Atle Lie McGrath (NOR/Head)** in Hafjell would see him join **Finn Christian Jagge (NOR)** in 2nd place for the most Slalom World Cup wins among Norwegian athletes. Currently McGrath shares 3rd place with **Ole Christian Furuseth (NOR)** at six wins both. **Henrik Kristoffersen (NOR/Van Deer)** leads this list with 26 victories.
- **Loic Meillard (SUI/Rossignol)** needs another top-3 finish to catch up with **Lise-Marie Morerod (SUI)** in 5th place on the list of the most Slalom World Cup podiums among Swiss athletes, men or women, with 15. Meillard is the only Swiss skier to have claimed a Slalom World Cup podium since the start of the 2024/25 season.
- **Loic Meillard (Rossignol)** needs one more top-10 finish to join **Beat Feuz** in the 5th place for the most Alpine World Cup top-10 results among male Swiss athletes with 113. **Didier Cuche** leads this list with 186 top-3 results.
- **Eduard Hallberg (FIN/ Fischer)** now has six Alpine World Cup top-10 results, he needs two more to draw level with **Henna Raita (FIN)** for the equal fifth place among Finnish skiers, men or women. Hallberg, who was named FIS Longines Rising Star in 2024/25, recorded only three top-15 finishes with a best result of 8th place before the current season.
