



QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FIS PARA CROSS-COUNTRY COMPETITIONS

SEASON 2026/2027

EDITION JULY 2026

1. Roller Ski, International FIS Para Cross-Country Competitions and Open National Championships

1.1 To compete in Roller Ski, International FIS Para Cross-Country and Open National Championship competitions all Athletes must:

- have a valid 2026/2027 FIS License issued in accordance with art. 203 of the ICR, which requires the upload of a valid Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) and if applicable, the registration of adaptive equipment.

2. Continental Cup

2.1 To compete in Continental Cup competitions all Athletes must:

- have a valid 2026/2027 FIS License issued in accordance with art. 203 of the ICR; and
- be internationally classified with a Sport Class Status Confirmed (C) or Review (R) with a Fixed Review Date 2027 or later (i.e., Review 2027 or later); and
- be ranked and have achieved FIS Para Cross-Country FIS Points.

3. World Cup

3.1 To compete in World Cup competitions all Athletes must:

- have a valid 2026/2027 FIS License issued in accordance with art. 203 of the ICR; and
- be internationally classified with a Sport Class Status Confirmed (C) or Review (R) with a Fixed Review Date 2027 or later (i.e., Review 2027 or later); and
- be ranked and have achieved for both Men and Women 400 points or less on the FIS Para Cross-Country Points list valid for the respective World Cup (please see art. 3.3).

3.2 To be eligible for a Wild Card, athletes must be ranked and have achieved 320 points or less in at least one competition on the applicable Points list (please see art. 3.3). Wild Card applications must be submitted through the official entry system, by the applicable deadlines.
