3. Athlete Eligibility

- To compete at the 2027 FIS Para Cross-Country World Championships all Athletes must:
 - Meet all eligibility criteria set out in the FIS Para Cross-Country International Competition Rules (ICR)
 - Have a valid 2026/2027 FIS Para Cross-Country licence issued in accordance with the art. 203 of the ICR;
 - Be internationally classified with a Sport Class Status Confirmed (C) or Review (R) with a Fixed Review Date 2027 or later (i.e., Review 2027 or later);
 - Be born in **2011 or earlier**.

- Athletes must be ranked and have achieved for both Women and Men 460 overall FIS points or less on the 6th FIS Para Cross-Country Points list (exceptions may be granted through Wild Card (see below) as of 19 January 2027).

Wild Card Eligibility

- To be eligible for a Wild Card, athletes must be ranked and have achieved for both Women and Men 340 points or less in at least one competition on the 6th FIS Para Cross-Country Points list as of 19 January 2027.
