

FACTS & FIGURES - Women's Slalom in Semmering

- The last Slalom race in Semmering was in 2022-23. Mikaela Shiffrin (USA/ Atomic) won, with Paula Moltzan (USA/ Rossignol) second and Lena Dürr (GER/ Head) third.
- There have been three Slalom races at Semmering over the last decade. Shiffrin won in December 2022 and December 2016. Michelle Gisin (SUI/ Salomon) won in December 2020.
- Camille Rast (SUI/ Head) currently leads the Slalom standings after three of 11 scheduled races. She was third in Gurgl and won the last Slalom in Killington.
- Rast was also third at the GS in Killington. These three results are the only podiums
 of the 25-year-old's World Cup career to date.
- Lena Dürr (GER/ Head) is currently third in the Slalom standings. Her best finish of the season so far was third place in Levi.
- Dürr was runner up to Shiffrin in the Slalom standings last season.
- She finished third the last time there was a women's Slalom in Semmering, in December 2022.
- Dürr's last Slalom win came at Špindlerův Mlýn in January 2023.
- Anna Swenn Larsson (SWE/ Head) is currently fourth in the Slalom standings, after coming second in Killington.
- Swenn Larsson has 15 career podiums but has never made the top three in Semmering.
- The last Swedish skier to reach the podium with a victory in Semmering's Slalom was Therese Borssen in 2006.
- Katharina Liensberger (AUT) is the only woman in the field with more than two career World Cup slalom victories. Liensberger has won three World Cup slaloms, the last coming in March 2022 in Are.
- Liensberger is currently fifth in the standings. She finished second in the opening Slalom of the season in Levi.
- The last Austrian to win in Semmering's Slalom was Marlies Schild in 2010.
- Paula Moltzan (USA/ Rossignol) finished second the last time the Slalom was raced in Semmering, in December 2022.
- Moltzan has one other podium in Slalom third place in Soldeu in February 2024.
- **Michelle Gisin (SUI/ Salomon)** is the only women's skier other than Shiffrin to win in Semmering over the last decade. She was first here in December 2020.
- That win in Semmering remains the only victory of Gisin's career. She has been on the podium 20 other times (six second places, 14 third places).
- Sara Hector (SWE/ Head), sixth in the Slalom standings last season, is currently 12th. Hector has never finished on the podium in Semmering.
- Lara Colturi (ALB/ Blizzard) is seventh in the standings overall, after coming second in Gurgl the first-ever podium in alpine skiing history for Albania.

- **Zrinka Ljutic (CRO/ Atomic)**, currently eight in the Slalom standings, has never finished on the podium in Semmering. The last Croatian athlete to win a World Cup race was Janica Kostelić in 2006
- Mikaela Shiffrin (USA/ Atomic), the defending Slalom Crystal Globe winner, is currently second in the standings after winning the first two Slaloms in Levi and Gurgl. She is sidelined with injury.
