2. Medal Events (12)

*This medal event mirrors the format of the Paralympic Winter Games 2026. This is a temporary measure until separate medal events for women SB-LL1 and SB-LL2 are approved for future Paralympic Winter Games.

3. Athlete Eligibility

- To compete at the 2025 FIS Para Snowboard World Championships all Athletes must:
 - Meet all eligibility criteria set out in the Para Snowboard International Competition Rules (ICR);
 - Have a valid 2024/2025 FIS licence issued in accordance with the art. 203 of the ICR;
 - Be internationally classified with a Sport Class Status Confirmed (C) or Review (R) with a Fixed Review Date 2025 or later (i.e., Review 2025 or later);
 - Be born in **2009 or earlier**.

4. Event-Specific Eligibility Criteria

4.1 Snowboard Cross and Snowboard Cross Team Event

- Athletes must be ranked and have the following points on the FIS Ranking List in Snowboard Cross as of 17 February 2025:
 - Men: 100 FIS points or more;
 - Women: 100 FIS Points or more.

4.2 Banked Slalom

- Athletes must be ranked and have the following points on the FIS Ranking List in Banked Slalom as of 17 February 2025:
 - Men: 100 FIS points or more;
 - Women: 100 FIS Points or more.

4.3 Wild Cards

Wild Cards can be requested for a FIS Snowboard Cross, Banked Slalom and Dual Banked Slalom World Cup by applying through FPDMS Online Entry System before the deadline.

A Wild Card request will only be considered if the Athlete has a minimum of 65 FIS points on the most recent FIS Points List in the respective discipline (65 FIS SBX points to request a Wild Card in SBX, 65 FIS BSL points to request a Wild Card in BSL/DBSL).

The decision whether a Wildcard is accepted or not will be delivered by the FIS Office in writing 48 hours after the application deadline.
