

FACTS & FIGURES - Women's Downhill Garmisch-Partenkirchen

- Sofia Goggia (ITA/Atomic) has won 19 World Cup Downhill races and can become the fourth woman to win 20, joining Lindsey Vonn (USA/Head, 43), Annemarie Moser-Pröll (AUT, 36) and Renate Götschl (AUT, 24.)
- In her last 17 World Cup Downhill races dating back to December 2022, Goggia has 14 podiums (seven wins, five seconds and two thirds), one fourth, and two DNFs.
- Goggia can win her first World Cup race in Garmisch. She has four career podiums in Garmisch (three Downhill, one Super G) – all runner-up finishes in four consecutive Garmisch races in 2018 and 2019.
- Goggia has won 26 World Cup races in all disciplines and can equal Maria Höfl-Riesch (GER) in 15th place on the all-time women's list with 27 victories.
- Lara Gut-Behrami (SUI/Head) can win her 46th World Cup race to equal Renate Götschl (AUT) in fifth place on the all-time women's list.
- Gut-Behrami can win her 14th World Cup Downhill race to equal Maria Walliser (SUI) in seventh place on the all-time women's list.
- Gut-Behrami is yet to win on the World Cup tour this season. In the last 12 seasons prior to this one, starting in 2012/13, she has won at least one race in every season except one (2018/19).
- Gut-Behrami can reach her 96th World Cup podium to surpass Anja Pärson (SWE) and move into outright sixth place on the all-time women's list.
- Federica Brignone (ITA/Rossignol) has won four World Cup races in all disciplines this season and can win five World Cup races in a single season for the third time in her career. She previously achieved five or more wins in 2019/20 (5) and 2023/24 (6).
- Brignone can win her 32nd World Cup race in all disciplines, which would move her into outright 11th place on the women's all-time list, one win behind Hanni Wenzel (LIE, 33) in 10th.
- Lindsey Vonn (USA/Head) has won five of her seven World Cup Downhill races in Garmisch, including the last four (2016-18). She has only missed the podium once and her worst result is seventh.
- Vonn can win her sixth World Cup Downhill race in Garmisch to equal Cortina d'Ampezzo as her second most successful resort. The only resort in which she has won more than six World Cup Downhill races is Lake Louise (14).
- Conny Hütter (AUT/Head) won the Super G in Garmisch in 2022 and can win multiple races in one resort for the first time in her career. Her eight World Cup wins have come in eight different resorts.
- Hütter can win three World Cup races in all disciplines in one season for the first time.
- Kajsa Vickhoff Lie (NOR/Head), who came second in the last Downhill race in Cortina d'Ampezzo, can reach the top 20 in a World Cup Downhill in Garmisch for the first time. She has recorded results of 22nd, 31st and DNF in her

previous Downhills in Garmisch, although her first World Cup podium, second in a Super G in 2021, came in the German resort.

• Corinne Suter (SUI/Head) can make Garmisch the scene of half of her World Cup victories. She can win her sixth World Cup race in total and third in Garmisch after winning a Super G there in 2020 and a Downhill in 2022.
