Warmly welcome to Lahti Ski Games from 5th to 8th of March 2026!

This year the competition program is truly historic. For the first time ever, women will compete in Nordic Combined World Cup in Finland, with an individual large hill event and a mixed team sprint competition on the program. The men's Nordic Combined will follow the same formats.

In Ski Jumping, women will compete in two individual large hill events, while the men's program includes both an individual event and a super team competition.

In Cross-Country skiing, the schedule features thrilling sprints in free and the Finnish fans' favorite distances: the 10 km individual start races in classic.




MAP OF MEDIA AREAS


PHOTO AREA MAP




COURSE MAPS

Nordic Combined Individual Gundersen – 2,5 km North NC




Nordic Combined Mixed Team Sprint – 1,5 km Sprint Karpalo




Cross Country Course maps: 1,5 km sprint and 5 km interval start

SIDE EVENTS

Lahti Ski Games is a legendary sport event with **over 100 years of legacy**. But nowadays it offers a variety of **festival elements** for its spectators as well.

When entering the venue, all will see the first ever **Walk of Fame by SEO**. Lahti Ski Games legends are collected on the same “walk of fame” board.

Oma Sp **Fan Zone**, located in the heart of the venue, top Finnish bands and artists will have an enormous show during the weekend. On the venue there is also a **recycling point for mobile phones and other devices** powered by Kuusakoski Recycling company and Finnish top band Apulanta. Every device is worth of one euro for the charity work for mental health of youth.

Thursday is the entry free day for the families and kids. Kids area in Karpalo (small hills) is full of excited actions points for kids. The area will open at 16:00 and the Hippo event will start at 17:30. After the women’s Large Hill competition in Ski Jumping, Finnish stars **Jenny Rautionaho** and local **Heta Hirvonen** will meet & greet the smallest fans.

Friday there will be **4000 elementary school students** on the area. Lahti Ski Games is part of the official school day. As well, on **Friday students have their own fest Frost Fest**.

After the Nordic Combined CC and prizegiving **six top social media influencers** will take part for the skiing challenge on the stadium. Who will win?

A flyover by two helicopters from the Finnish Defence Forces between the women’s and men’s NC ski races is scheduled for **17:25**.

Saturday the first-ever **movie “Mystery of a Golden Key” produced by AI** will be launched at **11:00** in the Ski Museum auditorium.

Ski Jumping Flag Ceremony performed by Lahti Ski Club ski jumping juniors will take place between men’s SJ qualification and competition, starting immediately after the hill preparation following the qualification is completed.

As we all know, the historical eight times Nordic World Ski Championships will take place in Lahti in the year of 2029. **WSC2029 visual elements** will be launched right after the men’s ski jumping competition and before the last part of the evening, **fireworks**.

On Sunday Team Salppuri, seven para and special skiers, will ski their own race between the women’s and men’s CC interval starts.

Old style wooden ski team “Puusuksi Team” will be on the venue during the weekend. You may spot them with blue and white clothes and wooden skis.

Ski Museum on the venue is open during the weekend.

See the competition area from breathtaking heights aboard the **Jalo&Jalo lift**. Rise above the action and enjoy a whole new perspective on the event. Best of all, the lift ride is **completely free!**

IN THE CASE OF EMERGENCY

PREVENTING ACCIDENTS

- Smoking takes place only in designated places.
- Emergency exits marked with green signs must be kept clear throughout the event.
- Report any hazards immediately to the Command Center (Tike).
- Warn others about possible danger.

IN CASE OF FIRE

- Rescue people in danger
- Warn others
- Call emergency center
- Extinguish with nearest fire extinguishers
- Prevent fire from spreading
- Guide rescue services to the scene via ice hall parking lot, along Salpausselänkatu and past the main building.

FIRST AID ACTION INSTRUCTIONS

This instruction also applies if you yourself are injured.

- Direct a person in need of help who can move to the on-duty first aid point at the event.
- Stewards will guide you or the injured person there.
- In a first aid emergency, call the Command Center (Tike), which will send help to the scene.
- If there is a life- or health-threatening situation, call 112. After the call, report what happened to the situation center. This ensures unobstructed access for rescue and first aid units to the area.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

Call 112 when you cannot wake up the patient, or they complain of breathing difficulties, chest pain, or are clearly injured.

- Call the emergency number yourself if you can.
- Describe what has happened.
- Give the exact address and municipality.

- Answer the questions.
- Follow the given instructions.

After calling emergency services, report the situation to the Command Center (Tike).

All safety-threatening situations and actions taken must be reported to the Command Center (Tike) 044 767 2144. The Command Center will give instructions for further actions.


