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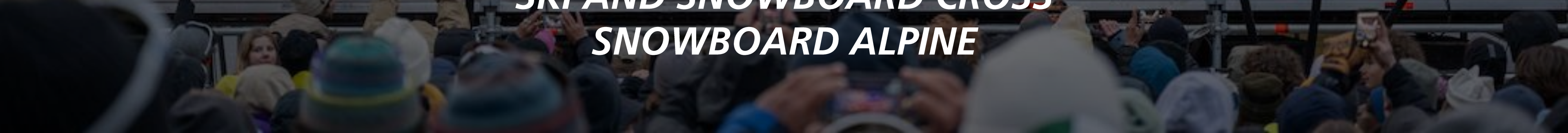
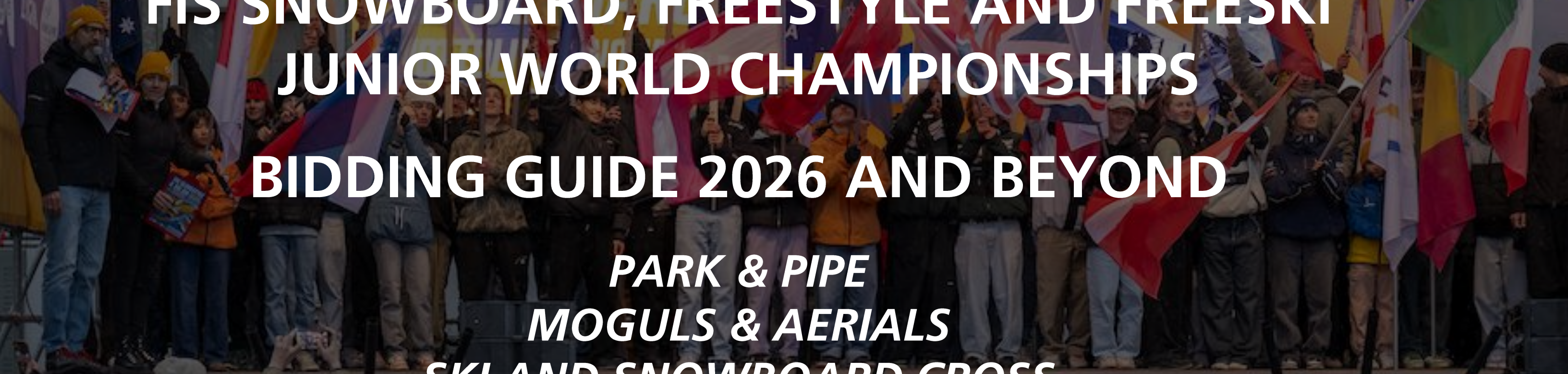

FIS SUPPORT

EVENT OPERATION SERVICES

FIS will offer comprehensive services and expert support:

TIMING & DATA

FIS provides the timing and data services.

ANTI-DOPING

Sample collection & laboratory analysis costs, as well as expert support on planning.

EXPERT KNOWLEDGE

Including: sports & operations, sports integrity (e.g. safeguarding), sustainability, education, digital & communications and more.

EVENT SUPPORT

Site inspections and event planning & delivery support.

MEDALS

Cost and delivery.

STUDY GROUPS

Participation in the study group programmes organized by the most recent JWSC and WSC Organisers.

JURY & JUDGES

Experienced personnel to be selected to ensure successful event delivery.

FIS SUPPORT

COMMERCIAL, DIGITAL AND BROADCAST

FIS will offer comprehensive services and expert support:

BROADCAST AND VISIBILITY

Knowledge transfer and expert support on the broadcast project (e.g. product definition, distribution, commentary etc.).

FIS CHANNELS

Access and visibility on the FIS digital channels including (but not limited to) social media, as well as YouTube and FIS TV (for livestreaming).

ORGANISER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

EVENT OPERATION SERVICES

Organisers are required to the fulfill Hosting Agreement obligations:

SIDE EVENTS

Organize side events and ceremonies, including opening, closing and medal ceremonies.

LOGISTICS

Accommodation and transport for athletes and teams, officials, timing and data provider, anti-doping and FIS staff (according to the JWSC Rules).

SPORTS & OPERATIONS

- Readiness of sports and operational areas (such as competition/training slopes and operational facilities);
- Video judging system.

SAFE & CLEAN SPORT

Promotion of safe sport and clean sport education activities.

ORGANISER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

COMMERCIAL, DIGITAL AND BROADCAST

Organisers are required to fulfill the Hosting Agreement obligations:

BROADCAST

Host broadcaster selection and live-stream production costs, including all medal events. (optional)

BRANDING

Event branding design and production (including start and finish installations, field of play branding, ceremony and interview backdrops etc.)

2	Informal dialogue	31 January 2025 - 15 April 2025	FIS offers hands-on support to help define the project.
3	Application deadline	15 April 2025	The candidates need to provide an application letter (signed by NSA & LOC) to events@fis-ski.com
4	Organiser appointment & agreement finalization	By 13 June 2025	FIS Evaluation Group recommends the preferred host to the FIS Council for appointment .
