ORGANISER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

COMMERCIAL, DIGITAL AND BROADCAST

Organisers are required to fulfill the Hosting Agreement obligations:

BROADCAST

Host broadcaster selection and live-stream production costs, including all medal events.

BRANDING

Event branding design and production (including start and finish installations, field of play branding, ceremony and interview backdrops etc.)

TIMING & DATA

The Data & Timing Service Provider for all competitions.

ORGANISER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

EVENT OPERATION SERVICES

Organisers are required to fulfill the Hosting Agreement obligations:

SIDE EVENTS

Organize side events and ceremonies, including opening, closing and medal ceremonies.

LOGISTICS

Accommodation and transport for athletes and teams, officials, timing and data & timing service provider, anti-doping and FIS staff (according to the WJC Rules).

SPORTS & OPERATIONS

Readiness of sports and operational areas (such as competition and training slopes/courses, and operational facilities).

SAFE & CLEAN SPORT

Promotion of safe sport and clean sport education activities.

APPLICATION PROCESS



	MILESTONE	DETAILS
1	Letter of intent	Provide FIS with a letter of intent plus information on proposed venues and infrastructure .
2	Informal dialogue	FIS offers hands-on support to help define the project.
3	Application deadline	The candidates need to provide an application letter (signed by NSA & LOC) to events@fis-ski.com
4	Organiser appointment & agreement finalization	FIS Evaluation Group recommends the preferred host to the FIS Council for appointment .
