1. General

This system can be used to register FIS competitions for FIS live results services on all competition levels.

Competitions for World Cup, World Championships, Olympic Winter Games and Youth Olympic Winter Games level will be further registered through the FIS office but timekeepers for those levels will be able to edit the competitions.

All entered data for live competitions will be saved in the FIS database and visible linked on the FIS website or in the FIS app.

The following FIS disciplines are still not supported by FIS live results service:

- Speed Skiing
- Freeride
- Para Cross-Country

The following categories, events or competition rounds are still not supported by FIS live results service:

General:

- Children
- Combined Disciplines
- Speed EC Event
- Round Robin format for Cross qualification

Freestyle:

Aerials Team (AET)

Para Alpine

- Parallel
- Team Parallel

Para Snowboard

- Dual Banked Slalom Team
- Snowboard Cross Team

Please register only competitions you will be using the FIS live results service!



1.1. Requirements

The timing or results software utilized must be compatible with the FIS Live Results XML feed. The latest version of the FIS Live Results XML feed specification can be found on FIS Member Section under section Documents \rightarrow Library \rightarrow FIS \rightarrow Timing and Data.

To register competitions, an account for the FIS Member Section of the FIS website is required. Accounts for the FIS Member Section can be requested from the FIS IT Department at it@fis-ski.com.

For account creation, please provide the information mentioned in article 3.1.

Please note that a FIS Member Section account can be issued only to an individual person.

1.2. FIS App notifications

Sending live data for a FIS competition can trigger FIS App notifications to thousands of users, so please take that into consideration when running live competitions. Do not send test data on real competitions. Examples of notifications that can be triggered:

- Favourite athlete is starting the competition
- Competition start list is available
- Favourite athlete is in start list for a competition
- Competition is in progress






2. How to search and register competitions

You find the Live Result Registration in the FIS website member section under Result Services → Live Results Registration.

- 1. Select the appropriate FIS discipline from the list.
- 2. Use the available search parameters like Codex to filter and locate the desired competition.
- 3. Once the competition is displayed in the list, you can:
 - a. Add a new competition
 - b. Edit, delete or find information about an existing competition



2.1. Live password

When registering your first test or official competition, you must enter a live password for data transmission. The password may include letters, numbers, and special characters. This password will be valid for all FIS disciplines and competitions by default but can be changed for each competition if required. When the password is updated, the new password will automatically apply to all subsequent competitions.



2.2. Test competition

Test competitions are available for software development and testing purposes. You may create up to two test competitions per FIS discipline to allow simultaneous testing (e.g., separate events for men and women).

To add a test competition, use the *Add test competition* button. Depending on the discipline, you can select different live results layouts for each test competition. The link to the FIS Live Results page for the test competition will be provided in the confirmation email or can be found using the information button for each competition.

After changing the layout, please refresh your browser completely to ensure the updated live results layout is displayed correctly.

2.3. Competitions

To register a new competition, you can enter and search for the FIS competition codex, which can be found in the FIS calendar on the official FIS website. If the entered competition codex exists, the search results will display all competitions within the event related to that codex.

Once a competition has been added, you can enter the start times for the runs or rounds using the local time of the event location.

Please note that the following competitions cannot be added or edited:

- Competitions with a date in the past
- Competitions that already have a result
- Competitions already covered by another timekeeper or data company
- Events that are not supported

If a competition is already covered by another timing company or timekeeper, and you encounter an issue or have questions about the coverage, you can use the provided contact link. This link will open a new email in your default email program, pre-filled with the timekeeper's email address and basic competition details. You can then add your message or inquiry.

If you are unable to provide live result data for a previously registered competition, please delete the competition from the registration system. This helps prevent inactive live result links from appearing on the FIS website.



2.4. Timekeeper or timekeeping hardware/software company logos and web links (optional)

For each competition, you can select the logo and the website URL of the timekeeper or the timekeeping hardware and/or software company from a predefined list. If a default web link is associated with a logo, it will be automatically applied upon selection. The URL can be edited at any time if needed.

If your company's logo is not available in the list and you wish to have it added, please contact the FIS IT Department and provide both the logo file and the default website URL.

Only logos that meet the following specifications will be accepted:

Maximum width: 480 pixelsMaximum height: 120 pixels

• File format: JPG, PNG, GIF or SVG

Maximum files size: 512 KB

All submitted logos will be verified and approved by FIS before becoming available for selection in the live result registration. The logo will appear on the FIS Live Results window.

2.5. Connection parameter

After registering a competition, you can view the connection parameters for live data transmission directly in the registered competition or test competition overview. To access this information, simply click the information button associated with the competition.

2.6. Confirmation email

For each added competition you will receive a confirmation email to your login email address with some competition related information and all necessary information for your live data transmission (host, port, password etc.). Confirmation emails for test competitions will also contain a link to the test competition. Links for test competitions can change according to the chosen layout.

You can find an overview of links for all live competitions on the FIS website available over the website navigation menu *Live Results* for each FIS discipline or through the FIS calendar on the FIS website or in the FIS app.



The Live Results overview pages display only a limited number of links for upcoming events with live results. Depending on how far in the future your competition is scheduled, the link to your registered live competition may not appear immediately. It is therefore recommended that you check the link a few days before the competition begins to ensure it is visible and functioning correctly.
