Remark:

The Quota Spots for Athletes and Officials can be exchanged within the nation for the Calculation of the Reimbursement of travelling expenses, e.g.: 1+2 or 2+1 Athletes/Officials for Starting Quota 2

Nations without any Quota are allowed to enter up to two (2) Athletes as a maximum as long as the participation right (see World Cup rules, art. 2.2) is fulfilled.

JWSC Starting Quota – respective NSA is allowed to use the quota for another athlete fulfilling the age criteria of the respective JWSC.
