3. Athlete Eligibility

- To compete at the 2025 FIS Para Alpine World Ski Championships all Athletes must:
 - Meet all eligibility criteria set out in the Para Alpine Skiing International Competition Rules (ICR);
 - Have a valid 2024/2025 FIS licence issued in accordance with the art. 203 of the ICR:
 - Be internationally classified with a Sport Class Status Confirmed (C) or Review (R) with a Fixed Review Date 2025 or later (i.e., Review 2025 or later);
 - o Be born in 2008 or earlier.

4. Event-Specific Eligibility Criteria

4.1 Slalom (SL)

- Athletes must be ranked and have the following points on the FIS Points List in Slalom as of 28 January 2025:
 - Men: 220 FIS points or less;
 - o Women: 220 FIS Points or less.

4.2 Giant Slalom (GS)

- Athletes must be ranked and have the following points on the FIS Points List in Giant Slalom as of 28 January 2025:
 - Men: 220 FIS points or less;
 - Women: 220 FIS Points or less.

4.3 Super-G (SG), Downhill (DH) and Alpine Combined (AC)

- Athletes must be ranked and have the following points on the FIS Points List in Super-G or Downhill as of 28 January 2025:
 - o Men: 170 FIS points or less;
 - Women: 170 FIS Points or less.

Note: If an athlete meets all other criteria but fails to earn the necessary FIS Points, a Wildcard Application may be submitted by the NSA to FIS for review. Please submit the Wildcard Application through the Online Entry System in FPDMS before the deadline.
