He has also served as a course builder at major events, including the FIS Freestyle Ski World Championships Kreischberg 2015, World Championships Bakuriani 2023, World Cup Valmalenco 2023, and the Montafon 2027 World Championships test event. His expertise combines coaching, technical officiating, event management, and course design at the highest international standard.
