

How to Cover The FIS Alpine World Cup

Thank you for your interest in the athletes and events of the Audi FIS Alpine Ski World Cup.

Our sporting tour has a unique structure that may seem unfamiliar to media professionals new to our events. However, we are a friendly group and greatly value all media interest in our sport. To assist you with your media projects, we've outlined the best methods for gathering content at our races and obtaining information from a distance.

ON-SITE AT ONE OF OUR EVENTS

1. Apply For Accreditation

Accreditation requests for World Cup events must be submitted individually to each Local Organising Committee (LOC) for the venue you wish to attend.

Links to media accreditation for each World Cup venue are available on each organizer's website or on our FIS website under [this link](#).

If you cannot find the contact person needed, you can always ask one of our FIS media coordinators.

2. Purchase Video/TV Rights [if applicable]

The multimedia rights of the World Cup belong to the National Ski Association, which commissions broadcast companies to manage those rights on their behalf. If you wish to film moving pictures with any kind of camera (even for social media use) or need footage from previous World Cup races, you must purchase the rights and obtain the necessary permission.

3. Request Interviews

National Ski Associations often have Team Press Attaches (TPAs) who are responsible for coordinating interview requests.

For all requests related to athletes and coaches, please reach out to the TPAs listed below. During the race, you can also approach the TPAs directly in the Mixed Zone. Don't hesitate to speak up and verbally request the interviews you're interested in!

If the athlete or coach you need to contact does not have a press attaché, you can always reach out to the FIS media coordinator, who is always on site.

All post race interviews are typically conducted in the mixed zone immediately after the race concludes. The FIS media coordinator together with the Chief of Media of the LOCs will provide information before each event regarding the possibility of a press conference.

For pre-race interviews, please provide advance notice of the athlete you wish to interview. The sooner you provide this information, the better it will be for both you and the athlete.
