

## FIS ALPINE SEASON ACCREDITATION SYSTEM 2026/2027

Update June 2026

The FIS Season Identification system establishes a standardised framework of access zones (1-9) and categories designed to ensure consistent access control, operational efficiency and clarity of roles across all FIS World Cup and FIS World Championships venues.

### **Accreditation Matrix:**

- The FIS accreditation structure and core categories below should be implemented without modification. LOCs/NSAs may add additional categories or areas to meet local operational needs (see below).
- FIS reserves the right to review, approve or reject access to certain areas as well as to coordinate the accreditations' categories and functions.
