World Cup, Inter- and Continental Cups (I-COC and COC), FIS Cup – Ski Jumping & Nordic Combined

Requirements for Equipment Control Room and Start Area Infrastructure

In accordance with the decisions and updated operational requirements for FIS Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined events, the following standards shall apply for all World Cup, Inter and Continental Cup (I-COC and COC), and FIS Cup competitions.

1. Equipment Control Room Requirements

The equipment control room shall be located near the exit gate and provide sufficient space and infrastructure to ensure efficient and professional equipment controls.

The room should be open space to facilitate the operational activities. A room divider or curtain separating waiting and control areas is no longer mandatory. Organizers should, whenever possible, avoid placing loudspeakers directly on or near the control room/container.

Minimum Facility Requirements

Room Size

- Double container setup preferred, or alternatively:
 - Minimum total area: 24 m²

Furniture

- 2–3 tables, minimum size:
 - 2.0 m × 0.8 m
- 1 smaller table for:
 - Laptop
 - Printer
 - Technical equipment
- 4–6 chairs depending on available space

Power & Connectivity

- Adequate power supply
- Minimum 3 four-way power distributors
- Stable internet connection / WLAN

Technical Equipment

- Direct, clear TV signal/feed of the competition (the so called “dirty feed”)
- Monitor for live competition viewing
- Printer:
 - Wireless printing, network-connected, or cable-connected

Climate & General Comfort

- Heating system operational from arrival of the equipment controllers
- Control room must be clean, dry and warm
- Functioning cooling system must be provided for the summer competitions.

Athlete Support & Logistics

- Drinks, snacks, and sweets available for athletes
- Option for athletes to safely store skis outside the control room:
 - Ski rack recommended

Additional Required Items

- Trash can
- Broom
- Doormat
- Sufficiently large carpet inside the room
- Small carpet (approx. 60 × 60 cm) for athletes use during control procedures

2. Start Area / In-Run Platform Requirements

The start area and immediate in-run platform must provide sufficient protection and functionality for athletes and officials.

Weather Protection

- The start area/platform (not necessarily the entire in-run) shall protect athletes from:
 - Rain
 - Snow
 - Wind
 - Other adverse weather conditions
- Roofing/covering remains mandatory.
- Sufficient number of blankets

Crotch Control Device

- The organizer must provide a spare crotch device. Generally, FIS's own devices are used.
- The crotch control device shall comply with current FIS regulations:
 - Updated measurement: 30 cm
- Device must be technically inspected and revised annually
- The start area shelter for the device should have approximately:
 - 1 × 1 m covered space

3. Start Control Assistance – WC (in special cases), ICOC, COC and FIS Cup

In special cases the OC will be asked to provide an assistant for the start control. If required, this will be communicated to the organizer in a separate request.

For FIS Cup competitions, the National Ski Association (NSA) or OC must nominate by name:

- One assistant per gender for start control duties

The nomination shall be included in the official event invitation if possible.

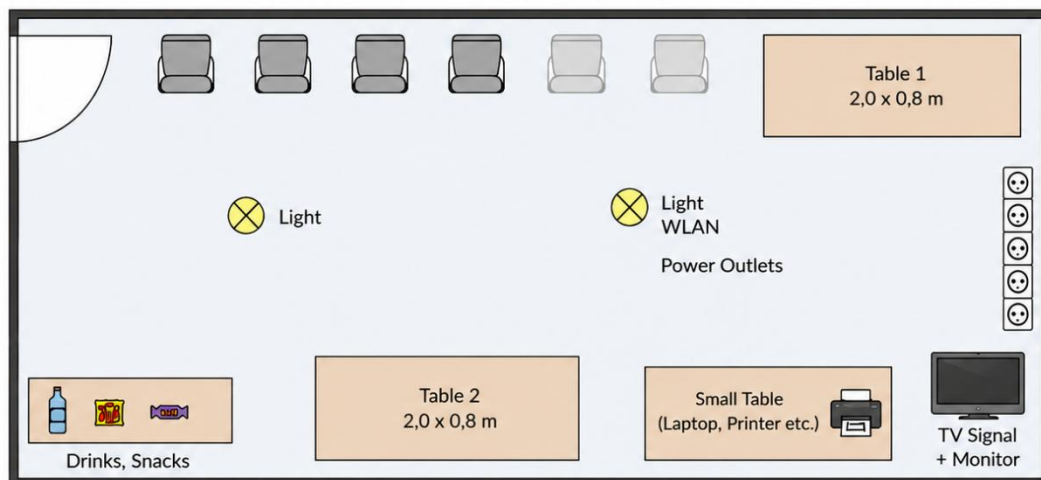
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FIS Equipment control container example



- 2 – 3 Tables at least 2,0 m x 0,8 m
- 1 Smaller Table (for laptop, printer etc.)
- 4 Chairs (against the wall)
- 2 Additional Chairs available (kept in the container)
- Power supply + 3 four-way power distributors
- Internet Connection (WLAN)
- TV Signal + Monitor
- Heating System
- Printer (Wireless / Network / Cable)
- Drinks, Snacks, Sweets (athletes)
- Option for athletes to safely store skis in front of the container (ski rack)
- Trash Can
- Broom, Doormat
- A sufficiently large carpet
- A small carpet (60 x 60 cm) for athletes
