FIS Development Program – Alpine Training Camp 1 Winter 2026

Dear Ski friends,

We are pleased to invite your athletes and coaches to participate in the FIS Development Program Alpine Training Camp in AUT and/or ITA. Information about the camp is as follows:

Dates: 01 November 2026 (arrival) – 21 November 2026 (departure)

Accommodation: Will be confirmed within the confirmation letter.

Eligibility Criteria:

Each eligible NSA may register:

- 1 female athlete
- 1 male athlete
- 1 coach

Athletes must:

- Be born between 1st January 2006 - 31st December 2010 (Junior World Ski Championships age limit).
- Have an active FIS Code.
- Hold between 120 and 250 FIS Points in SL or GS.

Coaches must:

- Hold a national coaching certificate/license.
- Have at least 2 years of coaching experience at the national level.

All participants must:

- Sign the FIS Development Camp declaration in advance of the camp.
- Be entered by the NSA via the registration link provided.

Equipment

Participants must bring all necessary equipment to participate in the camp, including but not limited to:

- Snow gear, skis (SL and GS only), boots, helmets, goggles and other protection (mandatory)
- Dryland training clothing

All athletes must be fully equipped to participate in all training sessions.

Note: NSAs may cancel participation latest 48 Hours after receiving the confirmation of participation letter. After the deadline for cancellation, FIS will issue an invoice for the full camp fees to the NSA Account. Insurance

All athletes and coaches must have adequate medical and accident insurance. Please bring a copy of your insurance policy with you to the camp in case of an emergency.

Registration

- **Maximum participants:** Athletes: 20, Coaches: Limited places available, subject to selection after registration

Please complete a separate Registration Form for each athlete and coach you are registering. Registration will be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis for eligible athletes. All NSAs who register will be notified of their participation by the latest one week after the Deadline.

Athletes are obliged to attend the full period of the Training Camp. If they do not, they will not be allowed to participate in future Training Camps organised by FIS (except in case of injury).

The camp coordinator and coaches reserve the right to send any athlete who needs to meet the necessary level for training home early.

Postponement or cancellation of the Camp

In the event of camp postponement or cancellation, FIS will promptly notify all registered participants. However, FIS is not liable for any costs incurred by NSAs as a result.
