

JUDGING AND TIMING PROTOCOL FOR TELEMARK WORLD CUP ORGANISERS

JUDGING PROTOCOL

- Check Judging Rules
- Organise a refreshing course and training for judges before the event
- Two gates per judge (three is possible in special circumstances)
- Judges in the yellow zone!
- Judges must be on the course during the inspection
- Judging must be organised by zones judges with flags signal a penalty to the zone judge, who sends penalties to the timing hut and writes them down on the paper
- Jump judges (3) two judges with flags (red is distance, blue is landing) and a radio, third judge for video judging
- Judging papers on fisski; correct marking no mistake, no marking, in case of disqualification, make a drawing
- If timing hut does not confirm getting penalties, the next racer **can not** start
- After a run, the Head of judges immediately bring all papers to the timing hut. Judges have to wait until the finish.

TIMING PROTOCOL

- When the race is officially confirmed by the TD, send XML files (Result list with FIS points, Penalty calculation and Timing report) immediately to results@fisski.com
