

PREVIEW MEN'S SLALOM ADELBODEN – Sunday 7 Jan 2024

Austria

- Austria has taken four of the six podium places in the opening two events of the men's World Cup slalom this season, including wins for **Manuel** Feller in Gurgl and **Marco Schwarz** in Madonna di Campiglio.
- Austria can win three consecutive men's World Cup slalom events for the first time since a run of four (all by Marcel Hirscher) from January to December 2018.
- A country has not won each of the opening three men's World Cup slalom events of a season since Italy's Giorgio Rocca won each of the first five in 2005/06.
- Austria has won 10 men's World Cup slalom events in Adelboden, only one fewer victory than all other countries combined (11).
- Of the 21 men's World Cup slalom events in Adelboden, only two did not feature an Austrian on the podium (2002 and 2023).
- Schwarz (second in Gurgl and first in Madonna di Campiglio) is top of the men's World Cup slalom standings after two events of 2023/24, but he will miss the rest of the season after tearing the cruciate ligament in his right knee in a fall during the World Cup downhill event in Bormio on 28 December.
- Michael Matt was second in the World Cup slalom event in Adelboden in 2018. His older brother, Mario Matt, won the World Cup slalom event in Adelboden in 2008.





Other contenders

- Henrik Kristoffersen (2) is one of two skiers to win multiple World Cup slalom events in Adelboden, alongside Marcel Hirscher (5). The Norwegian's two victories were in 2016 and 2017.
- Norwegians filled the top two places in last year's World Cup slalom event in Adelboden: Lucas Braathen (now retired) was first and Atle Lie McGrath was second. That was McGrath's most recent podium finish in a World Cup slalom event.
- Only once has **Daniel Yule** finished higher than seventh in a World Cup slalom event in Adelboden, but that was when he took victory in 2020.
- Dave Ryding (37y-033d) can become the oldest skier to record a podium finish in a World Cup slalom event, surpassing Giuliano Razzoli's third place at age 37 years and 29 days old in Wengen on 16 January 2022.
- Ryding was third in the World Cup slalom event in Madonna di Campiglio on 22 December. He has never finished on the podium in consecutive World Cup slalom participations.
- Clément Noël recorded a DNF in four of his six World Cup slalom events in Adelboden (second in 2019, eighth in 2021). The only French winner was Julien Lizeroux in 2010.
- Linus Straßer has not finished on the podium in a World Cup slalom event since a third place in Adelboden in 2023.
