

PREVIEW MEN'S SUPER TEAM LARGE HILL LAKE PLACID – Saturday 10 Feb 2024

- This is the fourth World Cup Super team event. All previous editions were won by different countries: Poland, Germany and Slovenia.
- **Poland**'s Dawid Kubacki and Piotr Zyla won the event in Lake Placid last season, ahead of Austria (2nd) and Japan (3rd).
- Poland can become the first country to win multiple Super team events at a single venue.
- **Slovenia**'s Anže Lanišek and Lovro Kos won the most recent men's World Cup Super team event, in Wisla on 13 January.
- Austria is the only country to have claimed a podium finish in all three Super Team events: second in Lake Placid, third in Râsnov and second in Wisla.
- **Stefan Kraft** (35) is level with Gregor Schlierenzauer (35) for most World Cup podiums in men's team events.
- Ryoyu Kobayashi and Naoki Nakamura claimed **Japan**'s only podium finish in a Super Team event when they finished third in Lake Placid last season.
- Japan won the only regular men's World Cup team event in United States, in Salt Lake City on 19 January 2001.
- No man has recorded as many podiums in World Cup Super team events as Germany's Andreas Wellinger (2). He finished first in Râsnov (with Karl Geiger) and third in Wisla (with Stephan Leyhe).
