

## PREVIEW WOMEN'S SUPER TEAM NORMAL HILL – Saturday 20 Jan 2024

- This is the second women Super team event, after last season's event in Zao on 14 January 2023.
- Austria's Chiara Kreuzer and Eva Pinkelnig won the event in Zao last season.
- Austria (5) won the most women's World Cup team events. Chiara Kreuzer was part of all five winning teams: Zao (18 January 2020), Ljubno ob Savinji (22 February 2020), Chaikovsky (28 march 2021), Hinzenbach (25 February 2022) and Zao (14 January 2023).
- Austria finished on the podium in eight out of the 10 women's World Cup team events (5 wins, one second place, two third places).
- Eva Pinkelnig won individual World Cup events in Oberstdorf and Sapporo this season. She finished second in both events in Villach.
- Norway finished second in the first Super team event last year, with Thea Minyan Bjørseth and Anna Odine Strøm.
- **Germany** finished third in the Super team event last year, with Katharina Schmid and Selina Freitag.
- Schmid finished second in the individual World Cup event in Sapporo on 14 January.
- Only Austria (3) recorded as many podium finishes in World Cup team events in Zao as **Japan** (3). Japan won the inaugural team event in Zao on 20 January 2018.
- Austria (8) and **Slovenia** (6) are the only countries with more than four podium finishes in women's World Cup team events.
