

PREVIEW MIXED 4X5KM RELAY GOMS – Friday 26 Jan 2024

- This is the fourth 4x5km mixed relay World Cup event, after Falun in March 2022 (USA won), Beitostølen in December 2022 (Norway won) and Falun in March 2023 (Sweden won).
- **Norway** is the only country to have finished on the podium in all three mixed relay World Cup events, including first and second place on home snow in Beitostølen.
- **Heidi Weng** is the only skier who finished on the podium in all three previous mixed relay World Cups (3rd-2nd-2nd).
- Norway's Simen Hegstad Krüger, Martin Løwstrøm Nyenget and Anne Kjersti Kalvå, and Sweden's Calle Halfvarsson each claimed two podium finishes with their teams.
- Calle Halfvarsson and **Jonna Sundling** are the two skiers to have won multiple mixed events in the World Cup, the team sprint in Falun in March 2022 and the 4x5km relay in March 2023. Halfvarsson will not participate in Goms.
- **USA** has won one World Cup relay event in any category (men, women, mixed), the 4x5km mixed relay in Falun in March 2022, with a team consisting of Rosie Brennan, Zak Ketterson, Scott Patterson and Jessica Diggins.
- **Switzerland** finished third in the 4x5km mixed relay at the U23 world championships in Whistler in 2023, behind France and Sweden.

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
