**1) INTRODUCTION**

The Sub-Committee for Masters Racing met in Zuerich during the FIS Fall Meetings but no new Rules changes were submitted to the FIS Council. For this season a single rule change was approved by Council on May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022 that can be seen below.

**2) REGISTRATION FEES FOR ALPINE MASTERS COMPETITORS**

The Alpine Masters Competitors will pay Registration Fees in the Season 2022/23 as in previous Seasons and NSAs will be invoiced for their ACTIVE MAS Competitors registered as of the 3rd FIS MAS Points List as well as all started athletes will be invoiced. **3) ADMINISTRATION OF “ACTIVE” MASTERS**

It is of utmost importance that all Team Captains and NSA Officials responsible for Entry Forms carefully check that ALL the competitors they enter to a FMC/MAS Competition are in an ACTIVE status at FIS. Competitors in an INACTIVE status will not be allowed to start. Also the change from INACTIVE to ACTIVE needs to be done before the next FIS MAS Points list is calculated.
