

Competition format for 2024 YOG Freestyle Dual Moguls

Version 1.0 (18 September 2023)

The following provisional rule sets are approved for use at the Youth Olympic Winter Games 2024 in addition to all other provisions of the ICR. Insofar as any rule here amends the provisions of the ICR, these rules shall prevail. In case of an irreconcilable conflict between these rules and the ICR, the Jury shall determine the outcome.

Competition format

Item	Description
Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Dual Moguls competition consists of Group Heats, Semifinals, Small Final and Big Final • Group Heats are held in a round robin format • Each heat is scored by seven judges. Four judges scoring turns, two judges scoring air and one judge scoring time difference. • The bib numbers are assigned based on the FIS Seeding List. The group heats are divided into heats of two competitors, based on bib numbers. Each competitor competes against all others in their panel in a round robin scheme (10 heats per panel). The winner of each heat is awarded three points, while the second ranked competitor receives two points, DNF receives one point, all other results marks, such as DNS will receive zero points. The first competitor that is marked as DNF shall receive one point while the other will be considered as the winner and will receive three points. The top competitor from each panel will advance to the Semifinals. • Composition of the Semifinals: The winner of Panel 1 will compete against the winner of Panel 4. The winner of Panel 2 will compete against the winner of Panel 3. • If a competitor is Disqualified (DSQ), he loses all points received in the Group Heats and is not allowed to continue competing in that event. The winners of the Semifinals advance to the Big Final and the other competitors advance to the Small Final.
Additional format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dual Moguls competition where competitors are directly seeded into the 1/16 final bracket.
Ties	<p><u>Heats (group heats, semifinals, finals):</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Should a tie occur, the competitor with the greater number of votes from the Turns judges shall be ranked higher; if still tied, the competitor with the greater number of Turns judges in favour shall be ranked higher. If still tied, the Turns Tie Break Judge shall determine the result by giving a Turns score. <p><u>After the Group Heats:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If multiple competitors are tied, the sum of all their earned points from their heats (judges votes, only considering the tied competitors) will be used to break the ties. The competitor with the higher sum will be ranked better. • If any ties remain, the competitor with the higher seeding position will be ranked higher.

	<p>Final Ranking:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ties will be broken by Group Heat Rank. If still tied - by Group Heat Points. If still tied competitors remain tied. If the Semifinals of the Big/Small Final cannot be held, competitors will be ranked by the results from the Group Heats.

Running order and heat pairing

Competitors will receive Bib numbers based on their FIS seeding rank (best seeded athlete with Bib 1) and will be distributed into panels and heats as defined in the table:
