

## Venue and Staff Requirements FIS World Cup BIG AIR (BA)

<b>Preparations - Staff / Material</b>	<b># of People</b>
BA venue according FIS World-Cup dimensions	
2 snowcats (one with cable-winch) 1 snowblower (if possible)	2 (snow grooming driver)
Shapers/Builders – needed during Kicker building	4-6 (with shovels)
Slippers with skis – needed during BA building if snowcat cannot cover all places	6-8 (with shovels)

Security – Crowd Control	6.8 around the ramp – depending on spectators and local-authority
Accreditation control	4.8 around the ramp – depending on different zones and spectators

Medical Person – Doctor	2 minimum at site – finish area
- SOS People with car (for all training and competition days)	4 two groups á 2 persons and 1 car – 1 crew have to leave 1 is still on site
Building Crew (separate Crew)	4-6 to help building TV-platforms, etc.

Accreditation control	6-10 round the ramp – depending on different zones and spectators
Exit-Gate control	1
Medical Person – Doctor	1 minimum at site – finish area
- SOS People with car (for all training and competition days)	4 two groups á 2 persons and 1 car – 1 crew have to leave 1 is still on site
Score/Results/Notice Board – Finish	2 to write down scores – radios OC
- Start	1 to write down scores – radios OC
Runner	2 1 copy for results, 1 for press
Building Crew (separate Crew)	4-6 to help building TV-platforms, etc.
Judges Stand	1 responsible for Judges-Stand
Skidoos incl. Driver (whole day)	1-5 depending on lift-situation
Award Ceremony (Place 1-3)	4 1 responsible person 3 to present the awards
Doping Control (not on each WC venue)	6 6 men (chaperones)

<b>Fencing / Padding</b>	1 m crowd control fence (RAZ) from start to finish on both sides to separate riders from general public. 1 m crowd control metal fence around the finish area covered with padding. B-net on both sides of the landing (2 x 20 meters). Other safety issues as per required by competition jury.
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<b>Judges Stand</b>	Out of scaffolding or Container – on the edge (flat-landing) – 7,5 x 2,5 meter (Container 5 x 2,5 meter) and 2 meter high - completely closed on three sides (water resistant) – with tables and chairs for 8 people. Heat and power for computer (separate electric circuit) are required.
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<b>Dye</b>	Blue for colouring kicker and landing (minimum 3 pumps)
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<b>Snow preparation</b>	If necessary we use fertilizer, regular-salt and water.
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<b>Official Notice Board</b>  <b>Scoreboard</b>	<p>A suitable board in the finish area (marked as “OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD”) - close to the exit gate (minimum 3 x 2 meters) to post official results, jury decisions, information etc. and to write down scores during Qualifications and Finals.</p> <p>A suitable board in the start area (minimum 1 x 2 meters) to post official results, jury decisions, information and to write down scores during Qualifications and Finals.</p>
<b>Riders Tent</b>	<p>Available for competitors - minimum 7 x 5 meters, closed, secured and heated with tables and chairs. (restaurant within 100m is adequate).</p>
<b>Drinking water</b>	<p>Hot tea and cold water (without gas) during training and competition for competitors.</p>
<b>Toilets</b>	<p>1 toilet located close (100m) to start area (portable toilets).</p>
<b>Sound System</b>  <b>Speaker</b>  <b>DJ</b>	<p>Specifications as per sound company and local situation – during competition not to loud that we can run the event. For training minimum music is required.</p> <p>English is required and respective national language – the best is two speakers (also for training, qualifications and awards).</p> <p>Very important – musical selection depends on the audience and local habits.</p>
<b>Communication / Radios</b>	<p>Up to 14 radios to run the competition (these are only for the sport not for security, concerts, etc.). OC needs extra radios for internal communication.</p>
<b>Ski Doo’s</b>	<p>A minimum of 3 ski doo’s (with drivers) are necessary for the finals in BA or a suitable lift just beside the BA-venue.</p>
<b>Data Building</b>	<p>A heated lockable building/container with power (separate electric circuit) and tables and chairs for 4 people (minimum 12 square meters), located adjacent to the judges stand on the ground is required. There are cables from this container to the judges stand and to the TV-compound. FIS data processing company (Swiss Timing) will provide more details.</p>

<b>Awards</b>	A stage (5x4 meter) beside the finish area (where TV cameras have easy access) with a table for the prizes. Before a corridor with 1 meter crowd control metal fence for press/TV/photo-graphers.
<b>Power</b>	Will be needed at: - Start                      - Judges Stand - Kicker                      - Flat - Data Building           - Finish-area - Award-Stage           - Riders Tent - Speaker/DJ
