### **Ski jumping ladies' team event added to world championships schedule**

- For the first time at world championships (or Olympic Games), there will be a ladies' ski jumping team event on the curriculum at the 2019 World Championships in Seefeld.
- The ladies' team event has been part of the World Cup since the 2017/2018 season. In that season both World Cup ladies' team events were won by Japan.
- The first ladies' team event in 2018/19 took place in Japan on 19 January 2019. It was won by Germany, ahead of Austria and Japan. A second ladies' team event was scheduled for Ljubno, Slovenia on 9 February 2019. Germany won again, ahead of Slovenia and Austria.
- Japan was the only team to finish on the podium in three of the first four World Cup ladies' team events (G2-S0-B1).
- This event has been held at the junior world championships since 2012. The last three ladies' team events in the competition were won by Russia (2019), Slovenia (2018) and Germany (2017).
