## EXCERPT - RULES FIS CROSS-COUNTRY WORLD CUP 2019/20

### 3.1.4 Additional quotas COC leaders or winners

The Overall Winners from the previous season's COC have the right to start in the 1<sup>st</sup> World Cup period in the following season (beginning 2019/20 season).

The leaders (women and men) of all COC Cups at the following dates have the right to start in World Cup competitions during the next World Cup period:

1 <sup>st</sup> World Cup Period 2019/20	COC Winners season 2018-2019
2 <sup>nd</sup> World Cup Period 2019/20	Leaders at 24 <sup>th</sup> of December 2019
3 <sup>rd</sup> World Cup Period 2019/20	Leaders at 07 <sup>th</sup> of January 2020
4 <sup>th</sup> World Cup Period 2019/20	Leaders at 11 <sup>th</sup> of February 2020
5 <sup>th</sup> World Cup Period 2019/20	Leaders at 25 <sup>th</sup> of February 2020

A valid list of these qualified athletes will be published on the FIS website. Each COC Coordinator is responsible to send the names of the qualified athletes to the FIS Office (aschhoff@fisski.com) according to the following deadlines:

1 <sup>st</sup> World Cup Period	1 <sup>st</sup> of November 2019
2 <sup>nd</sup> World Cup Period	24 <sup>th</sup> of December 2019
3 <sup>rd</sup> World Cup Period	07 <sup>th</sup> of January 2020
4 <sup>th</sup> World Cup Period	11 <sup>th</sup> of February 2020
5 <sup>th</sup> World Cup Period	25 <sup>th</sup> of February 2020

These additional quotas are nominative, the athletes cannot be substituted if they cannot start due to force majeure.

**The athletes have to reach the World Cup entry requirements (see art. 3.2).**

**The winners and the current leaders (1 person per gender) of these Continental Cups will get reimbursement according to art. 10.1.**

In case of a tie, the spot will be awarded according to the following principle: If two or more competitors score the same number of points, the spot will be given to the competitor who has:

- the highest number of individual COC wins
- the best results (i.e. most 2<sup>nd</sup> places, most 3<sup>rd</sup> places, etc.)

If the competitors are still equal, they will all get an additional quota.

### 3.3 World Cup Entry Requirements

**3.3.1** The quota is valid under the condition that every individual competitor (Women and Men) has an active FIS code number and has reached during the last 365 days at least one (1) result better than or equalizing:

**Sprint World Cup:**

- **120 FIS Points (Sprint or Distance).**

**Distance World Cup:**

- **60 FIS Distance points Men**
- **90 FIS Distance points Women**
- **120 FIS Distance Points for the athletes from the National Group (art. 3.1.5)**
