World Cup points	Athletes will be able to score up to 400 points in the World Cup, taking all individual competitions into consideration
Trophies	The Best Jumper and Best Skier Trophy leader will wear a bib with a blue and red mark instead of a start number and will also receive prize money at the end of the season.
Prize money	Prize money at individual competitions: 10,000 CHF (Top 10) Prize money at Team/Mixed Team events: 30,000 CHF (Top 3 teams) Individual World Cup win: 2,800 CHF Mixed Team World Cup win: 16,000 CHF Overall Prize Money: 1000 CHF per competition will be taken from the overall prize money pool and the final amount split between the Best Jumper and Skier Trophy winners and the overall world Cup Top 3. In case of cancellations, the prize money has to be adapted. For the exact split, see World Cup rules 5.1.4.
