TD / JURY / JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS

- World Cup TDs may be assigned from different regions if they are not subject of high potential risk region/nation - FIS Covid-19 Passport will be required;
- All other TD assignments will be done locally and/or regionally;
- Follow Local Organising Committee and follow up on National/Local Health organisation guidelines;
- Local Organising Committee will provide Covid-19 Prevention Measures document according to National Health regulations in addition to Race Invitation information



FIS OFFICIALS TESTING

FIS World / Continental Cup Competition Management

- RT-PCR testing subject to the regulations of the respective national health authorities which are decisive
- Implementing national / LOC regulations of next event
- Or other valid reason i.e. "Yes" to question/s in FIS Health Questionnaire
- Blood antibodies screening every 2 months

1. Database contains all **Events** and **LOC Information**
2. Participants receive **invitation** from FIS to **register** in the system
 - a. Approved participants can access Whereabouts and Test-Management Portal
3. Select Events participating and
 - a. complete webform with **Covid-19 Test** results
 - b. fill in **Whereabouts** for defined **period** including other FIS Events
5. Chatbot asks **health** questions per local/event questionnaire
6. Status reviewed for participant by Event as defined by rules

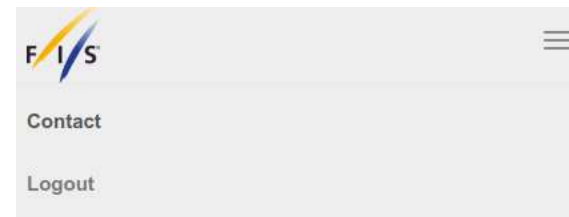

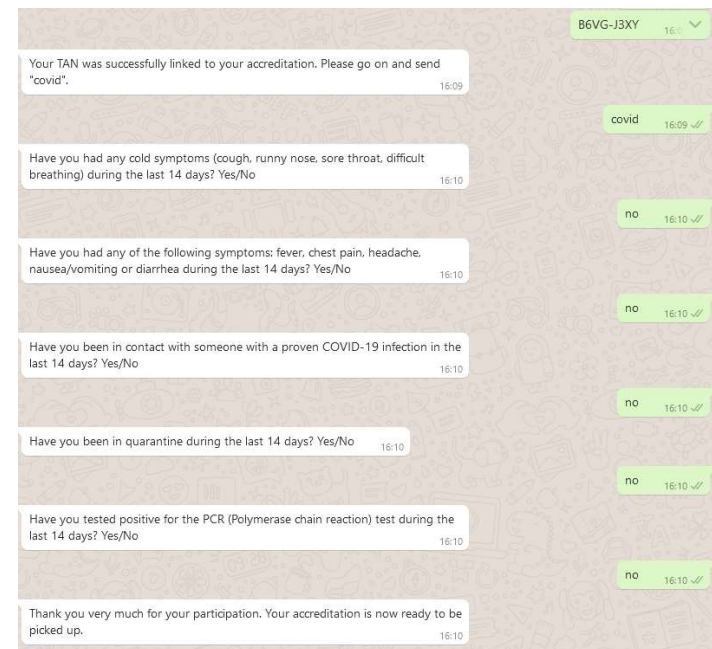

FIS PASSPORT – WELLBEING CHATBOT

- Assessing the daily health status
- Chatbot via SMS, WhatsApp or Mail
- Simple but effective
- Questionnaire configurable per Event





FIS PASSPORT – LOC FIS PASSPORT STATUS CHECK

- LOC will get access to a **secured web-application** on request to FIS
- **Export** via Excel/CSV possible (only race relevant data)



FIS COVID-19 MEDICAL SUPPORT GROUP

The **FIS C-19 Prevention Guidelines** give the **greatest possible security** to protect yourself against infection

In addition to the various test options you should **never forget**: Wash your hands, keep your distance, wear a mask and ventilate.

These measures are **extremely** important, **very effective** and **inexpensive**

TESTING PROTOCOL - AUTHORITY - DISCIPLINE

FIS World Cup Risk Management Covid-19 Testing Protocol

Objective: To minimise risk of Covid-19 within the **FIS World Cup Snowflake**

Authority: **National Health Regulations** are **decisive** in every country and arrange testing on-site. FIS Protocol does not define testing frequency, quarantine period/s, etc.

Discipline: Every person **must adhere** to the **policies**, follow procedures, instructions and **behave** in a **disciplined** manner at all times. **Breach** of discipline protocol will lead to **withdrawal** of **accreditation** and suspension of 14 days **quarantine** from participating at **FIS World Cup** or other level **event/s**



TESTING COSTS - EXECUTION - INFORMATION

Stakeholders and/or individual **persons** are **responsible** for own **costs** for own testing including **on-site** by nationally **approved/certified** Covid testing

Test **Execution** carried out in accordance with **best practice**

Results Recording and Whereabouts Monitoring/Tracking

Compulsory **registration** in the central and GDPR compliant **FIS C-19 Database** to be eligible for **accreditation and** establish each person's Covid-19 **FIS Passport**. Self-recording of daily **whereabouts** country/ies and **recording** of **testing** dates.



COVID-19 EXPERTISE - RESOURCES

Covid-19 Expertise - Local and FIS

National health authority coordinator has **responsibility** for implementation **regulations** per event and providing advise before and on site.

FIS expertise available by phone/messages to national health authority coordinator, onsite FIS official/s and Event Task Force through the **FIS Medical Committee Covid-19 Project Group** and C-19 Expert, Rasmus Damsgaard:

Event Management Logistics through expert **providers** e.g. Skidata may be helpful for **LOC**

A positive result will be reported according to national protocols

Event Task Force and actions

FIS TD, LOC, NSA and national health authority coordinator instruct affected person of obligations

Illness

At sign of illness report to national health authority coordinator immediately and take precautionary measures
