We have pleasure reminding all interested National Ski Associations to submit their candidacy for hosting the above-mentioned events with the following deadlines:

Candidatures for the FIS Ski Flying World Championships in 2024 and the FIS Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Championships in 2025 have to be submitted by 1st March 2021 as decided by the Council.

Furthermore, we also kindly inform you that the candidatures for the FIS World Championships 2026 (Ski Flying) and 2027 (Alpine, Nordic, Snowboard Freestyle and Freeski) have to be submitted by the 1st May 2021.

Applications for the organisation of the above-mentioned FIS World Championships according to the respective rules have to be sent to the FIS Director before the indicated deadlines together with the registration fee and guarantee for training days.

Furthermore, the application shall include the following:

- Written confirmation that the Candidate agrees to conform in all respects with FIS Rules for the Organisation of FIS World Championships per article 1.3 of these rules.
- A statement that the Candidate – to the best of its ability – will not allow any discrimination in regard to affiliated National Associations or their individual members on account of racial, religious, political or other grounds.

After submission of the candidacy FIS will provide each Candidate and its National Ski Association with a detailed questionnaire for completion. Consequently the Candidate is requested and recommended not to produce a brochure or such like with the application in order to facilitate the process.
