

## PREVIEW MEN'S TEAM - SKI FLYING – Saturday 27 Mar 2021

### Norway

- Norway won the team ski flying world title in Planica on 13 December 2020. Halvor Egner Granerud, Daniel-André Tande, Johann André Forfang and Robert Johansson were Norway's ski jumpers that day.
- Norway (8) also is the country to have won most team ski flying World Cup events, including a record five in Planica.
- Norway came only sixth in the most recent World Cup team event in ski flying, held in Planica on 23 March 2019.
- Johann André Forfang could become the first man to be part of six winning teams in ski flying World Cup team events. He currently is equal on five wins with his compatriot Andreas Stjernen and Austrians Martin Koch and Gregor Schlierenzauer.
- In all World Cup team events, Norway (27) is still trailing Austria (32) on most wins in team events.

### Austria

- Austria (32) has won most team events in the World Cup, including two wins in this season (Norway has one win in 2020/21).
- In ski flying team World Cup events, Austria have won five World Cups, second-most behind Norway's eight.
- Austria's last victory in a team ski flying World Cup dates back to 17 March 2012, when it won the World Cup event in Planica.
- Austria finished sixth in the team ski flying world championships in Planica on 13 December.

### Germany

- Germany finished second in the team event at the ski flying world championships in Planica on 13 December.
- In all team events, Germany has won 15 World Cups. Only Austria (32) and Norway (27) have won more.
- Germany's only win in a team event in ski flying was in the first-ever World Cup team event in ski flying, in Planica on 18 March 2000.
- Germany finished second in each of the last three World Cup team events in ski flying in Planica (2017, 2018, 2019).

### Other contenders

- **Poland** won the most recent World Cup team event in ski flying, in Planica on 23 March 2019. It was Poland's first World Cup triumph in a team ski flying event.
- Poland finished third in the team event at the ski flying world championships in Planica on 13 December.



- **Slovenia** has won 10 World Cup team events, most recently in Vikersund (ski flying) on 16 March 2019. It has won four team events in ski flying in the World Cup.
- Slovenia won two World Cup ski flying team events on home snow in Planica, in 2013 and 2015.
- **Japan** has won four team events in the World Cup, but not since a victory in Salt Lake City on 19 January 2001.
- Japan has yet to win a ski flying team event in the World Cup. It finished on the podium two times, both third places in Planica (2000 and 2001).
