

FIS Covid-19 Prevention Guidelines

- FIS expert recommendations based mainly on data/guidelines/recommendations by WHO
 (World Health Organization) and Robert-Koch-Institute (RKI) Berlin, Germany
- Additional experiences from winter season 2020/21
- National Health Regulations are paramount

BUT

- A mandatory FIS minimum standard is required
- FIS Covid-19 prevention guidelines are dynamic and need regular update






SARS-CoV-2 mutants and variants of concern

- SARS-CoV-2 is an RNA virus
- Mutations are normal
 - Incomplete proof-reading process during viral genome replication
- New mutations are constantly generating during the viral replication
- Mutation will increase infectivity: alfa, beta, gamma

World-wide problem: DELTA VARIANT





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SARS-CoV-2 variants and COVID-19

- Are often more infectious
- May escape neutralising antibodies (from previous infection or from vaccination)
- May cause more severe COVID-19 disease course
 - Mutations may be responsible for increased morbidity/mortality
 - Increased incidente of immune dysfunction may similarly increase morbidity/mortality in absence of further mutations
- Mutations/variants are selected based on selective pressure for the virus
 - Current, selection of viral mutants is based on infectiousness
 - In the future, mutant selection may be based on escape from incomplete immunity

FIS Covid-19 Prevention Guidelines

We need responsibility and discipline of all persons otherwise the best preventive concept will fail!



FIS Covid-19 Prevention Guidelines – Vaccination

Until we have more knowledge of transmission of Covid-19 in vaccinated individuals, the FIS experts are very clear that all precautions – testing, masks, distance, hand-washing, no shared air – MUST be maintained by vaccinated as well as non-vaccinated individuals





Covid-19 Information

- FIS Educational Webinars virus information, vaccination, outlook by expert
 - Conclusion: Risk Mitigation / Prevention / Responsibility as travelling population
- Virus & Infection status
 - Variants (more infectious), dynamic development (others expected)
 - More infections BUT due to vaccination lower number of serious cases
 - Spread of virus before symptoms
- National «openings» vs Global picture (travelling vs local population)
- Prevention
 - Follow rules (hygiene); Wear masks & Get vaccinated






Covid-19 does not allow any compromises!



Covid-19 Protocol - TESTING CONCEPT Winter

- 1. Entry test (prior to Event- Accreditation), 72 hours prior PCR test only!
- During Event «C19 Prevention Proof or Test» (after Day 2/3),
 Valid vaccination/previously infected; or another C19 Test on site (PCR/Antigen)
- FIS Passport Use (reads QR code EU Green Pass)
- Importance of Separation between travelling bubble if LOC/other group lower standard in line with national risk assessment





FIS Covid-19 Prevention Guidelines – Arguments pro a strict testing protocol

- A higher mass immunity is needed (e.g., at least 80% of participants vaccinated)
- New variants with numerous higher infections -> C-19 cluster formation more rapidly
- Travelling population
- Only high-level PCR testing will catch the new variants
- Vaccination protects the vaccinated person, but carrying and transmission of the virus is still possible

- Basic Registration with Code (FIS2022)
- Apply for events
- Select Events participating
 - a. complete webform with Covid-19 Test results
 - b. health questionnaire per event
- Status reviewed for participant by Event as defined by rules
- Dedicated portal for LOC's and NSA's

 - b. PCR Test validation prior event
 - c. PCR/Antigen Test validation during event
- Update required information




FIS PASSPORT - GREEN PASS VALIDATION

Vaccine or recovery validation on main registration page Successful validation



Unsuccessful validation



- **Upload COVID Certificate**
 - EU Digital COVID Certificates can be validated
 - All others cannot be validated → manual input required
- Validity rules
 - The valid duration can be configured on a global level for vaccines and recoveries

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FIS PASSPORT - GREEN PASS VALIDATION

PCR Test validation prior event and during event


- Prior event:
 - a. Upload COVID Certificate
 - b. EU Digital COVID Certificates can be validated
 - c. All others cannot be validated \rightarrow manual input required
- During event
 - a. Upload COVID Certificate
 - b. Integrated Testing Software for LOCs

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FIS PASSPORT - Update required information


- Participants needs to enter missing information first, before entering the event application page
 - a. Main COVID information
 - b. Staff ID (if applicable)
 - c. FIS Code (if applicable)





FIS PASSPORT - Health Questionnaire UPDATE

- Enable Disable Chatbot per event
- Configurable Sending time (outside CET Zone)



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FIS PASSPORT – LOC portal UPDATES

- Display status of each participant depending on COVID rules incl. automated updates
- PCR Test indication
 - a. Pre-event PCR test is done
 - b. Onsite PCR/Antigen Test is required
 - c. Display number of additional PCR tests




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FIS PASSPORT – NSA portal UPDATES

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FIS PASSPORT – API / Interface for LOC's

- API for local Accreditation systems (implementation of REST API required)
- This REST-API allows the LOC to automatically export / transfer data from the FIS
 Passport System in order to use it for other applications like accreditation system, lab
 system, reporting tools.
- Provided data:
 - a. Main data of participant incl. Covid health status
 - b. Event relevant data (registration status, health questionnaire status, PCR test required information, etc.)



FIS PASSPORT - Staff ID and FIS Code validation

- Automated validation of Staff ID and FIS Code via a feed from FIS Entries system
- Explanation where Staff ID can be found:

Validation of EU Digital COVID Certificate

- On Android devices
- Web application

Additional Information on display:

- Valid from until
- Not valid because
 - a. Covid Rule is not fullfilled (e.g. PCR test older than 72 hrs
 - b. Only 1 of 2 vaccines done
