<b>Events</b>	25 World Cup competitions in 11 venues: 22 Individual Gundersen events, 1 Team Sprint, 1 Team Event, 1 Mixed Team Event
<b>Title events</b>	<p><b>Olympic Winter Games Beijing (CHN)</b> February 5 – 20, 2022, LOC = CST Men Ind. Gundersen: February 9; 16:00 SJ HS 106, 19:00 XC 10 km Men Ind. <b>Highlights</b>	<p><b>Ruka Tour</b> – November 26 - 28 in <b>Ruka (FIN)</b> Friday - Ind. Gundersen, 1 jump &amp; 5 km cross-country Saturday - Ind. Gundersen, 1 jump &amp; 10 km cross-country Sunday - Ind. Gundersen, 1 jump &amp; 10 km cross-country Normal World Cup points for each competition. No elimination after the first competitions, every day has a new qualification. The athlete with the highest amount of World Cup points from all three events is the tour winner.</p> <p><b>Nordic Combined TRIPLE</b> – January 28 - 30 in <b>Seefeld (AUT)</b> Friday – Ind. Gundersen, 1 jump &amp; 7.5 km cross-country Saturday – Ind. Gundersen, 1 jump &amp; 10 km cross-country Sunday – Final Ind. Gundersen, 1 jump &amp; 12.5 km cross-country The athletes will receive fixed points after Day 1 results and bring them to Day 2, the same for Day 3. The first athlete crossing the finish line on Day 3 is the TRIPLE winner.</p>
<b>World Cup points</b>	Athletes will be able to score up to 2200 points in the World Cup, taking all individual competitions into consideration
<b>Trophies</b>	The Best Jumper and Best Skier Trophy leader will wear a bib with a blue and red mark instead of a start number and will also receive prize money at the end of the season.
<b>Prize money</b>	<p>Prize money at individual competitions: 33,150 CHF (Top 20) Prize money at Team/Team Sprint events: 30,000 CHF (Top 3 teams) Individual World Cup win: 8,000 CHF Team World Cup win: 16,000 CHF Team Sprint World Cup win: 12,000 CHF</p> <p>2000 CHF per competition will be paid into an overall prize money pool and the final amount split between the overall Top 3 and the Best Skier and Best Jumper Trophy winners. In case of cancellations, the prize money will be adapted. For the exact split, see World Cup rules 5.1.4.</p>
