### Women's Nordic Combined: News Season 2021/22

<b>Events</b>	10 World Cup competitions in 6 venues: 8 Individual Gundersen events, 1 Mixed Team event, 1 Mass Start
<b>Title events</b>	<b>FIS Nordic Junior World Championships Zakopane (POL)</b> February 27 – March 06, 2022, LOC = CET Women Ind. Gundersen: March 2 ; Mixed Team: March 4
<b>Highlights</b>	First-ever Nordic Combined World Cup Mixed Team event and Women Mass Start in Val di Fiemme (ITA)
<b>World Cup points</b>	Athletes will be able to score up to 800 points in the World Cup, taking all individual competitions into consideration
<b>Trophies</b>	The Best Jumper and Best Skier Trophy leader will wear a bib with a blue and red mark instead of a start number and will also receive prize money at the end of the season.
<b>Prize money</b>	Prize money at individual competitions: 13,000 CHF (Top 15) Prize money at Mixed Team events: 30,000 CHF (Top 3 teams) Individual World Cup win: 4,000 CHF Mixed Team World Cup win: 16,000 CHF  <b>Overall Prize Money:</b> 1000 CHF per competition will be taken from the overall prize money pool and the final amount split between the Best Jumper and Skier Trophy winners and the overall World Cup Top 3. In case of cancellations, the prize money has to be adapted. For the exact split, see World Cup rules 5.1.4.
