

PREVIEW MIXED TEAM COURCHEVEL – Friday 18 Mar 2022

- The team event has been held at the World Cup Finals ever since the 2005/06 season, with the exception of 2007/08 when it was cancelled due to bad weather. In 2019/20, the entire World Cup Finals were cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
- **Switzerland** won the team event a record four times at the World Cup Finals (3 by Austria). The Swiss also won gold in this event at the Olympic Winter Games (2018) and world championships (2019).
- Wendy Holdener is the only person to have won this event four times at the World Cup Finals as she was part of all four of Switzerland's winning teams. She also helped Switzerland win the Olympic and world title in this event.
- Holdener is level with Michaela Kirchgasser (both 6) on most mixed team wins at the Olympic Games, world championships and World Cup Finals combined.
- **Austria** won the mixed team event at the 2022 Olympic Winter Games in Beijing, finishing ahead of Germany (silver) and Norway (bronze).
- Austria finished on the podium in nine of the previous 14 team events at the World Cup Finals, most of all countries (Sweden, Switzerland and Germany next on 7).
- Austria achieved a record three gold medals and a joint-record six total medals (also 6 by Sweden) in this event at the world championships.
- **Norway's** five podium finishes in the team event at world level all came in the last four years: bronze at the 2018 and 2022 Olympic Winter Games, gold at the 2021 World Championships, first place at the 2020/21 World Cup Finals and a second place at the 2018/19 World Cup Finals.
- **Germany** (2011, 2013) and **Sweden** (2017, 2018) won the team event twice at the World Cup Finals. They could join Switzerland (4) and Austria (3) on at least three team wins at the World Cup Finals.
- Lena Dürr (9) could equal Michaela Kirchgasser and André Myhrer on a record 10 podium finishes in the mixed team event at the Olympic Games, world championships and World Cup Finals combined.
